



Warren County Fair County Born Market Lamb Registration Form

Due May 1, 2019 by 4:30 p.m. to the Warren County Extension office.
This form must be completed in full, including signatures, by the deadline.

- 1) No late forms will be accepted. Forms will not be accepted at tagging.
- 2) Forms must be filled out completely, including signatures, by the deadline.
- 3) Animals without completed forms on file by the deadline will not be tagged as county born market lambs.
- 4) All market lambs must be tagged on May 11, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. at the Warren County Fairgrounds. Three market lambs may be tagged, but only two lambs may be exhibited at the fair.
- 5) Since the ownership deadline is May 1, 2019 and only three market lambs may be tagged:
 - No substitutions can be made after this form's deadline.
 - Only three market lambs may be registered per exhibitor.
 - Only one exhibitor can be listed as the owner. Family or farm names not permitted.
 - The animal's ear tag number must match this registration form at tagging or they will be ineligible for county born classes.

County Born Eligibility Rules

- 1) Lambs must have been produced by a Warren County sheep producer. The ewe must be owned by the producer and the project must be lambing in Warren County. With the exception of breeding season, ewes must be housed in Warren County year round. Ewes lambing or permanently residing in other counties or states, even if they are owned by a Warren County sheep producer, are not eligible for the county born class.
- 2) Ewe lambs must have a scrapie tag at county weigh-in.
- 3) Market lambs must have an ear tag that matches this registration form. Market lambs without ear tags will not be tagged as county born. A scrapie tag with a farm number and individual number are acceptable for identifying both wethers and ewe lambs.
- 4) The breeder must sign this form stating all information provided is true.
- 5) Warren County Fair personnel reserve the right to inspect ewes and lambs to verify location, ownership and existence.
