
2. Click "view" by the member's name you would like to add an animal for.




3. Click "Animals" on the left hand panel.




4. Click "Add Animal" in the top right corner




5. Select the "type of animal" you are enrolling from the list. Under "identifier" put county born tag number or ear notch.

Market Hogs

Swine - Market

- Enter one form for each market hog.
- A maximum of three hogs may be entered per exhibitor.

Animal Age: Not Required.

Animal Name Not required. Optional information.

Beginning Weight: Not Required

Beginning Weight Date: Not Required

Birthdate: Required. Enter month, date & year (mm/dd/yyyy)

Breed: <u>Required.</u> If the breed is not known, answer Crossbred. Most Warren County fair hogs are crossbreds. Hogs with blue/gray spots are crossbreds. Black hogs are crossbreds. Black hogs with a white stripe behind their shoulders are Hampshire. Consult your 4-H Market Hog resource guide for breed pictures, but most hogs will be marked as "crossbreds".

Breeder Name: Required. Type the farm name or individual that bred your hog. This information will be used to cross-check county-born information.

County Raised: <u>Required.</u> Check this box if this hog was born in Warren County and is eligible for the county born class.

Earnotch: Required. See the attached sheet for information on reading ear notches.

RFID Number: Not Required.

Sex: Required.

Tag: Required. Hogs must have an identifier. Type one of the following numbers:

- o First Choice: County Born tag number. Required if the hog is county born.
- If the hog is not county born, then type a farm tag number or ear notch number.

Tattoo: Not Required.

Three pictures of the hog must be attached to this animal information form. One must be a front view, left side and right side view. A picture of the county born tag or ear notch must also be attached under "Animal Photo-Identifier"
