*Exhibitors not in the participating counties will be charged a \$10.00 entry fee per class entered.

* Exhibitors may enter a maximum of four classes.

***Please note: If there are not at least three entries in the over fences classes by the June 10th entry deadline, we will not offer over fences classes. In the event that those classes are not offered, any exhibitors who did enter will be notified by phone call by Wednesday June 12th.**

***Entry deadline is June 10, 2019.** Entry Forms and class fees need to be to the Warren Co. Extension office no later than 4:30 pm. Late forms will be accepted until Wednesday, June 12th, with a \$5.00 late fee. Post entries (day of show) will be accepted with a \$10.00 late fee.

All participants (which include but is not limited to, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, handler and the horse) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that all equine activities involve inherent risk of serious injury, death or loss to person or property. And by participating, they expressly assume any and all risks of injury, death or loss. They agree to indemnify and hold harmless, the competition (including but not limited to, their officials, sponsors, directors, employees and agents), from and against all claims including any injury, death or loss suffered during or in connections with competition, whether or not such claim, injury, death or loss resulted, directly or indirectly from the negligent acts of omissions of said officials, sponsors, directors, employees or agents of the competition. The inherent risks of equine activity include but are not limited to, any of the following: the propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death or loss to persons on or around the equine; the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movements, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; hazards, including but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; a collision with another equine, another animal, a person or object; and the potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to an injury, death or loss to the participant or another person, including but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.
